

Recruitment of Devon LA KS1 Moderators 2018-19

Babcock LDP is seeking to appoint additional KS1 moderators to complete statutory KS1 external moderation visits in June 2019. The role of a LA moderator is open to qualified and serving Year 2 practitioners, both Headteachers and teachers, who meet the requirements below:

- Recent Y2 teaching experience
- Experience and understanding of the National Curriculum and the current KS1 teacher assessment frameworks for reading and writing. Training on the new maths framework will be provided
- Secure subject expertise and knowledge of progression in KS1 writing and end of Year 2 expectations
- Experience of leading the moderation of teacher assessments internally and externally throughout the year and at the end of KS1
- Ability to enter into professional dialogue with colleagues regarding the end of KS1 TA judgements
- Senior or middle leadership experience
- Ability to drive and own car
- School authorisation to work outside the school for up to 10 days each year.

All Babcock LDP LA moderators will receive training for the role and will have to be available undertake the Standards and Testing Agency standardisation of writing exercise arranged for **December 13th 2018**. The STA will issue approval letters to moderators who successfully complete the exercise. Only those moderators who are successful will be approved to moderate in 2019.

KS1 Moderators will be required to:

- Register as a Babcock Associate
- Make themselves available for up to 10 days each academic year including up to 5 days during three week moderation window in June 2019.
- Attend up to three moderator training days (including the STA standardisation of writing day)
- Send emails and make telephone calls to schools in order to confirm moderation visits
- Complete a written report following the moderation visit

Funding

The school of each moderator will receive funding to cover their release.
